

CONTINUE TO SUPPORT THE FARMERS ADVERSE EVENTS TRUST AFTER YOU ARE GONE

You can assist the farmers impacted by adverse events in the future by leaving a bequest in your will to the Farmers Adverse Events Trust. With a bequest to the Federated Farmers Adverse Events Trust, you can be sure your bequeathed funds will be used solely for providing support and resources to farmers and rural communities nationwide, during and after significant adverse events.

Bequests can be challenged by your family if they don't feel adequately provided for and the Farmers Adverse Events Trust encourages you to discuss your wishes with your family. Discuss the amount you wish to leave so it is not likely to be contested and also discuss your reasoning with them. You need to be comfortable with the decision you have made, and family understanding can help with this.

TYPES OF BEQUESTS

A gift left in a bequest can take various forms, depending on your preference and situation. The main types of bequests are:

Residuary request

The balance left in your estate after all other expenses, debts and other bequests have been settled. It may also be a percentage of your estate.

A specific bequest

A particular monetary amount or a specific item, such as the proceeds of a life insurance policy, shares, homes, art works and more.

Whole estate

A bequest of your entire estate, usually for those without dependants, to achieve something special.

NEXT STEPS: WORDING YOUR WILL

If you have an existing will, and you wish to amend it to include a bequest to the Farmers Adverse Events Trust, please contact your legal advisor. They will help you change your will through a codicil (a document that amends a previously executed will). This usually has a nominal cost.

Choose one of the following options:

- 1. I give (X) percent of the residue of my estate to the Farmers Adverse Event Trust.
- 2. I give (\$amount) to the Farmers Adverse Events Trust.
- 3. I give the residue of my estate to the Farmers Adverse Events Trust.

The Farmers Adverse Events Trust:
